

Michigan Foundational Policy Checklist



The following checklist lays out policies Michigan currently **has in place** (☑) and those it **still needs to pass** (○) to create a safer state for Michiganders:

Background checks required for sales:

- ☑ By licensed dealers
- ☑ By private parties
- ☑ At gun shows

- ☑ Negligence-based Child Access Prevention law

Safe storage requirements in:

- Home
- Vehicles

Firearm Purchaser Licensing:

- Live-fire safety training
- ☑ In-person application component
- Fingerprinting
- ☑ Enhanced background check
- Waiting period between application and approval or denial

Reporting lost and stolen guns:

- Lost
- ☑ Stolen

Concealed carry permit requirements:

- ☑ Live-fire safety training
- ☑ In-person application component
- ☑ Fingerprints
- ☑ Enhanced background check

Open carry regulations:

- Open carry prohibited
- Permit required for open carry

Public carry location restrictions:

- ☑ Schools
- Government buildings
- ☑ Polling places
- Protests

- No Stand Your Ground Law

- Waiting period between purchase and acquisition

Firearm prohibitions:

- Violent misdemeanors
- ☑ Domestic violence misdemeanors
- ☑ Persons subject to domestic violence protective orders
- Hate crime misdemeanors

- ☑ Extreme Risk Protection Orders

- Minimum age of 21 for all gun purchases

Firearms relinquishment:

- DV protective orders
- DV misdemeanor crimes
- All other prohibiting events

- Prohibit assault weapons

- Prohibit large capacity magazines

- Regulate ghost guns

- Allows Gun Industry Accountability

- Allows localities to enact their own laws

- ☑ Funding for Community Violence Intervention

- Require dealer licensing
